



Here are two BINGO cards for you to use: one that's been filled out and a blank one for you to fill with items from the list below.

Things to Look For

- leaf changing colors
- leaf that will stay green
(Remember—needles are leaves, too!)
- animal storing food
(squirrel burying an acorn, bird stashing seeds in a tree, pika drying grasses)
- abandoned bird nest
- mushroom (Some are poisonous, so don't touch.)
- second kind of mushroom
- bird that will be around all winter (If you aren't sure, check a bird guide for your area.)
- flying flock of geese, ducks, or cranes
- dried seed on a plant
- BIG fallen leaf
- tiny fallen leaf
- animal feeding (Many animals are eating as much as they can to prepare for a long migration, hibernation, or winter with little food.)
- berry
- cocoon/chrysalis
- insect home (tent caterpillar nest, paper wasp nest, insect gall)
- cool wind or rain on your cheek
- bud on the end of a tree twig (Trees have already made buds for next spring's growth!)
- tree nut (acorn, walnut, hickory nut)
- something blooming
- something red
- something orange
- cricket chirping
- frost or ice
- snow in the mountains
